

Established in 1968, Bach Vespers was the first series of its kind in the Western Hemisphere and is based on the great tradition Johann Sebastian followed in 18th century Leipzig. It has been named "A Cultural Landmark" by the New York Landmarks Conservancy and noted for its "valuable" contribution to the city's arts community.

Our Bach Choir, Soloists and Bach Players (on Baroque period instruments) are comprised of outstanding professional musicians from the New York region and are directed by Cantor Rick Erickson.

Bach Vespers is free and open to all regardless of religious affiliation or beliefs. We do request a free-will offering during the service. Fourth Mondays Concerts have a \$15/\$10 admission at the door and offer a diverse musical presentation beyond our regular cantata series.
