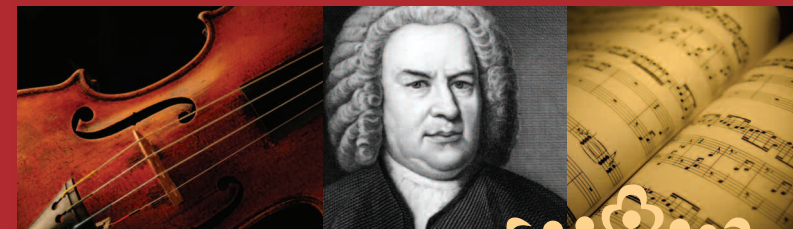

Daily Schedule

The day begins at 9:00 a.m. with Morning Prayer and includes rehearsals for both choir

and orchestra. Each day includes workshops with guest speakers and clinicians. Lunch is included. The day concludes at 4:00 p.m. (except for those who choose the on-campus housing option).

On Friday at 7:15 p.m. camp participants will lead the Bach Cantata Vespers worship service, including the performance of Cantata #137, *Lobe den Herren, den mächtigen König der Ehren* (Praise to the Lord, the Almighty, the King of Creation).

Application Process

Application Deadline: June 15, 2010

- Download the application and recommendation forms from www.bachvespers.org/camp and send to Grace by mail or electronically (information below) no later than June 15, 2010.
- All new students must submit a recording of their instrument or voice. Returning students need not prepare an audition recording if they intend to sing in the choir.
 - Vocal recordings must include two solo works demonstrating technical facility and interpretation. Keyboard accompaniment is preferred.
 - Instrumental recordings must include two solo works demonstrating technical facility and interpretation as well as three major and three minor scales. Keyboard accompaniment is preferred, unless not required in the score.
 - Recordings must be received in one of the following forms: cassette tape, CD, DVD, mp3, or online video post (e-mail file or link to mcostello@gracriverforest.org).
- Submit \$75 application fee (or full tuition) online at www.bachvespers.org/camp or send a check payable to Grace Lutheran Church (write Cantata Camp in the memo line).
