

Eleventh Annual Bach Fest - 2010

Last year's Hudson Valley BachFest was a resounding success! Our festival keeps getting larger every year - we began in 2000 with two concerts and last year we presented five! BachFest has become a multi-county phenomenon, with various churches throughout Dutchess, Ulster, Sullivan and Orange counties offering Bach services on BachFest Sunday morning. We are truly delighted with the continued success of the festival and look forward to many joyous years of sharing Bach's music with the Hudson Valley community.

Some highlights from the 2009 BachFest included:

- Gifted elementary, middle and high school students performed in the Young Performers' Concert.
- World-renowned organist Gale Archer performed in a wonderful recital of Bach's organ works.
- The BachFest Choir and Orchestra, directed by Laura Ramsey Russell, gave a moving performance of Bach's monumental work *St. Matthew Passion* to critical acclaim at Christ Church.
- The Sunday concert at Cornwall Presbyterian Church featured a spirited performance of the *Brandenburg Concerto No.* 2, under the direction of Edward Lundergan.

Our 11th annual Hudson Valley BachFest, to be held on Friday, August 27 through Sunday, August 29, 2010, promises to be equally as exciting! Our Saturday evening choral concert, at Christ Episcopal Church in Poughkeepsie (August 28), will feature the BachFest Choir, comprised of dedicated singers from all over the Hudson Valley, and the BachFest Orchestra in a performance of two of Bach's most beloved church cantatas, Cantata 80, Ein feste Burg ist unser Gott and Cantata 140, Wachet auf, ruft uns die Stimme. The concert will also feature opening choral movements and instrumental sinfonias from several of Bach's other cantatas. Our Sunday afternoon concert at the Cornwall Presbyterian Church in Cornwall-on-Hudson (August 29) will feature the Orchestral Suite No. 2 in B Minor for solo flute and orchestra, and a performance of Bach's motet Jesu, meine Freude by the BachFest Chamber Choir. We will also again feature our Young Performers' Concert on Saturday, August 28, and what BachFest would be complete without our beloved Keyboard Marathon, this year featuring Bach's Partitas, on Friday, August 27, both in Cornwall. Please check the BachFest schedule for exact dates and times.

The response to BachFest by the public has been overwhelming and deeply gratifying. If you've been to one of our Bachfest concerts, you know how wonderful and magical they are. If you haven't, we invite you to join us this summer to experience Bach's music in all of its majestic glory.
