Born in 1685, Handel and Bach never met, but they came close, and both studied with the great Dietrich Buxtehude. Bach's solo alto Cantata 54 *Widerstehe doch der Sünde* is flanked by Buxtehude's joyful Cantata 4 *Alles, was ihr tut*, and Handel's virtuosic and fiery *Dixit Dominus*.
