Johann Sebastian Bach: Das Wohltemperierte Clavier – The Works for Harpsichord Vol. 1

In this first release in Musica
Omnia's complete survey of Bach's
music for solo harpsichord, Peter
Watchorn presents the composer's
seminal collection, The WellTempered Clavier from 1722, using
the Well-Tempered tuning for which
the work was composed. The use of
a fully independent pedal adds bass
sonority reminiscent of the organ
to the harpsichord's clarity and
brilliance, resulting in performances
of unparalleled depth and power.
